


















OPAC Icons in Evergreen






The following table identifies the search and icon formats in Evergreen. Codes used within a MARC record's Leader and Control Fields during cataloging will determine which icon is applied to the record. The Type of Record and/or Bibliographic Level are cataloged within the MARC record's leader. The Form, Format, and/or Specific Material Designation are cataloged in the 006, 007, and/or 008 control fields. Evergreen's MARC Editor includes a Physical Characteristics Wizard for easy modification of the 007 field.

Evergreen uses information from these fields when examining the database to find the best search results. This is most easily observed in Advanced Search.

The letter designations below are MARC standards; however, this chart does not represent all available codes for all categories.
